LEGISLATION

Legislation requires that all employees receive suitable and sufficient instruction and training on the actions to be taken in order to safeguard themselves and others in the event of fire. Staff should know the locations of the fire extinguishers in their workplace and how to operate them. Anyone working in an area, such as a kitchen, where a fire is more likely to occur, should receive additional practical training in the use of the extinguishers provided.

(wood, paper, textiles etc)

Flammable Liquids

(solvents, paint, fuel etc)



CLASS C

Flammable Gasses

(butane, propane, LPG etc)



CLASS D

Metals

(Lithium, magnesium etc)

Cooking Oils

(cooking fats and oils etc)

DON'T FORGET

- All extinguishers will need to be serviced once a year by a competent technician.
- Extinguishers should be suitably signed with the appropriate extinguisher identity sign.
- Extinguishers should be wall mounted using suitable brackets, placed on extinguisher stands or placed in extinguisher cabinets.
- Suitable and sufficient training should be provided for the use of extinguishers which is to be conducted by a competent person with the training documented as evidence of completed (Don't forget to refresh it)
